## **7. Twyford News** – At the printers and due for distribution at the end of April.

7.1 Extension of distribution to include Ruscombe PC. This is felt to be a good idea because resident of Ruscombe use Twyford facilities and planning applications for Ruscombe affect their use. Initial discussions held with Ruscombe PC who is interested in considering this further. There would be a few changes in content to include a report from Ruscombe PC Chairman and the odd article about Ruscombe. Ruscombe would be responsible for arranging the delivery. 500 additional copies will be required for Ruscombe and the first joint issue could be in the autumn if final arrangements are agreed and approved by the council. Cost not discussed in detail with RPC yet. Following a discussion on various methods of calculating the charge to be made to RPC it was agreed that the initial proposal to be made to them will be on the basis of Twyford's existing unit cost of production.
